Kern County Cemetery District

Management Update

- We had 16 services in Shafter and 6 services in Wasco for the month of November 2020. This gives us 151 for the fiscal year-to-date.
- The Covid Relief Fund being accessed by the County of Kern has accepted our application for certain reimbursements.

Security Camera Policy

The Trustee's reviewed the policy for our security cameras. No changes were reviewed and the policy stands as discussed at the last meeting.

The motion to accept the Security Camera Policy was made by Trustee Banks and seconded by Trustee Ezell, roll call vote, 3 ayes; unanimous.

Covid Policy

The Trustee's reviewed the California Occupational Safety and Health Standards Board ("Cal/OSHA") recent emergency regulations from November 19, 2020. (Refer to 8 Cal. Code of Regulations §§ 3205 – 3205.4.)

Cal/OSHA chose to pass several costly (and extensively debated) regulations, including: continuation of pay and benefits for employees excluded from work due to COVID-19; prohibiting employers from requiring negative COVID-19 tests for returning employees; and no-cost testing for employees in many circumstances. These regulations went into effect on November 30, 2020 and will remain in effect (unless extended by Cal/OSHA) with a sunset of October 2, 2021.

The board discussed the reason for the length of the policy and the work that will be needed upon implementation. Also discussed was the addendums that will be used at the time of an outbreak of Covid.

No action taken. This policy will have a final review at the next board meeting.
